A superbly decorated late 19th Century Hoshiarpur occasional table from British India. Teak with intense brass inlay filigree top, an unusual flower shape top makes this piece much more desirable, the top also features a fruitwood and ebony chevron edge detail. Raised on 8 legs with inlaid arched panel sides.

A superb decorator's piece, will add texture and warmth to a room. The teakwood has a lovely warm aged tone that only comes with age.

In good original condition throughout, some losses to the brass inlaid (see photos) but this by no means takes away from the piece. Circa 1880, made in British Indian, authenticated by the remanence of an old label on the underside (see photo)
