This rare original stone trough is uniquely formed from sedimentary stone, unlike common sandstone troughs this is an exceedingly early primitive example made of Sedimentary rock. Sedimentary rocks are types of rock that are formed by the accumulation of mineral or organic particles at the Earth's surface.

Dating back to 18th century, it has uniquely formed and weathered over 250 years to give it a beauty that can only be created by nature, making this an exclusive piece of garden/home décor.

A lovely focal piece to any Garden, would also look wonderful in a large room or as stand to a large plant pot. A very heavy large piece.

Overall size as detailed, the centre carved dish measures 64cm x 26cm x 5cm / 25" x 10" x 2"
