A very attractive gothic influenced Regency period chair. Beautifully made with delicate proportions, highly original with worn ebonised finish and parcel gilt decoration. Finished with a contrasting cane seat.

The chair has strong influences of Ford Madox Brown of the William Morris design company, the



dainty gothic fretwork, front legs and petite turned spindles is typical of the designs produced by Brown, however, it is difficult to assign the piece directly to Brown. There are no visible makers mark on the Chair.

The chair has a couple of small historic repairs which are well aged, the piece is in good sound order, and is a lovely petite decorative chair.
