

## LARGE CAST BRONZE 19TH CENTURY ALTER CROSS

An outstanding 19th Century solid cast phosphor bronze alter cross in the form of Fleur-de-lis (often used to depict Mary or the Holly Trinity). Dating to circa 1880's, this aesthetic piece is beautifully crafted with elegant knurled detail, inset with milk glass roundels and a large faceted red glass cobochon.

Inscribed with the Christogram IHS being the monogram symbolizing Jesus from the Greek abbreviation of the name  $IH\Sigma OY\Sigma$ .





Standing at 2ft in height, this makes an uniquely decorative relic of the highest quality.
