A lovely designer piece by Gimson and Slater, England. Gimson and Slater were a company making high end contemporary sofas and chairs in the 1960s and 1970s, this red patchwork leather is typical of their unique design of the late 60s early 70s period. A striking looking chair and very comfortable with generous seat.

The lower section is covered in a darker red cloth material which contrasts nicely against the high quality patchwork leather, the seat and back cushions are fixed with the two armchair cushions removable.

In very good clean condition, there is one small hole in the bottom left corner where the cloth has worn on the corner (as per photo), but overall this is a great looking comfortable chair.
