

MID CENTURY WELSH WOOL TAPESTRY BLANKET IN AUTUMNAL BROWN AND GREEN

A single size Welsh wool tapestry blanket measuring 244cm (96") x 168cm (66")+fringe

Known for their exceptional quality and craftsmanship, this example has an earthy brown and green colourway with hues of pale reds and salmon-pink, creating a warm autumnal feel, these traditional woven blankets are double sided, which provides interest and texture, and the versatility to change the colour tone by simply turning over.

Baring its original label, made in Brynker Woollen Mill , Brynker mill was originally a corn mill and was converted to a woollen mill in circa 1850, an original water wheel mill which was one of the last surviving in Wales.

This example is in excellent condition, no holes, with good fringe. One of two matching blankets we have available, the other is a king (large) size, please refer to other listing. The second image shows the blankets side-by-side.



The double-sided tapestry pattern adds depth and interest, making this blanket a versatile addition to an interiors space adding texture and warmth. Use it on a bed for added warmth or as a comforting throw on your sofa. Not just for cozy nights in, these blankets are also ideal for summer picnics, providing a stylish and warm option for outdoor gatherings.
