

## OLD HAND PAINTED CHINESE DOORS

A very old, probably late 19th Century, pair of hand painted Chinese panelled cupboard doors. Each door has a painting of a lady, the left carrying a back pack and a bamboo 'wand' or 'bindle' - sometimes used to carry medicine. The right hand image depicts a lady gazing down holding an umbrella. Each door has trees and foliage with red berries/flowers in the top panels. The images appear to be raised and painted on Gesso.



Each door has ornate brass corner plates and a decorative central escutcheon.

The doors are in sound usable condition either as cupboard doors or as wall art. The condition of the paint is chipped and has a fantastic crackled aged appearance. We like the doors in this natural state, however, the doors could be lacquered to further protect the finish and provide a more vibrant finish.
