The unusual square tapered design, possibly a primitive mortar, provides ample room to display your favourite plants, succulents, or fresh herbs. Whether placed indoors or out, this planter adds a zen-inspired, nature-infused accent to any space. Ideal for use as a Bonsai Pot.

There are no drainage holes, so it also holds water and could be used as a small bird bath.

The primitive shape and irregular surface creates a striking, sculptural silhouette that complements both modern and traditional decor. The natural stone has a beautiful rustic organic feel, perfect for those wanting to introduce that wabi-sabi touch to a room or garden, adding an earthy charm.

Durable enough for outdoor use, this planter could also be used indoors to bring a touch of the outdoors in. Its self-contained design makes it easy to move and position as needed. Use it to



anchor a vignette, flank a fireplace, or dot along a windowsill.
