The natural organic shape provides an excellent backdrop as a garden feature, the shallow trough holds water and could be used as a bird bath or water feature around a pond areas. Despite its age, this sturdy stone planter is in excellent condition, ready to grace your garden or home with a distinctive charm.

Use it outdoors to add texture and age to a new garden design, or display it indoors as a unique decorative accent piece. Its versatile nature also makes it an ideal bonsai display with the perfect wabi sabi look.
