A highly decorative, early form, European bench seat of superb character. A primitive, yet well built petite bench seat with single plank seat and tapering splayed legs.

The backrest and sides consist of scroll detailing, a pure hand made piece, typically found in villages and farmhouses in Austria and Eastern Europe, this particular example has a fantastically vibrant, almost turquoise blue, paint in its original form with worn patina.

Some historic repairs, give this piece a wondaful rustic originality that cannot be matched by reproduction pieces. The piece is in good sound condition and has been checked at our workshop with small repairs made to joints to ensure the piece lives on for many more years. The piece is clean and ready for installation. A great designer piece for those wanting to add character and texture to a room.
